1. 熟悉邻居、地区的历史及现状。查明各个的画廊、画室、咖啡店、酒吧代替了谁的家、商业。参与社区会议、注意状况及消息。
2. 在我邻里、拥护低中收入人需要的企业和服务。
3. 与社区倡导者分享信息、资源、工作空间、技能、一起避免房东犯法加租，虐待、骚扰住客而赚钱。
4. 支持正在为了保留家园而奋斗的邻居。理解贵族化及警察骚扰有连带关系的。报告警察骚扰、阻止纽约市警察局违反我邻居的公民权利。
5. 答应不租不卖住客无故被驱逐而空出的单元。支持邻居抵制止赎、强迫迁离、买断。
6. 声讨利用“特洛伊木马”策略(弹出式商店、画廊、咖啡店、流行的售货亭)来激发房地产的开发商者。
7. 支持华埠住客要求市议会及市长通过华埠工作小组的社区规划。这个重划区计划反映到唐人街住客的需要、能保护今日和将来的低收入房屋、能保留我们的地区、而阻拦驱逐。
8. 提供语言需求。把我的任务说明、新闻稿、通知都翻译成中文及西班牙文。

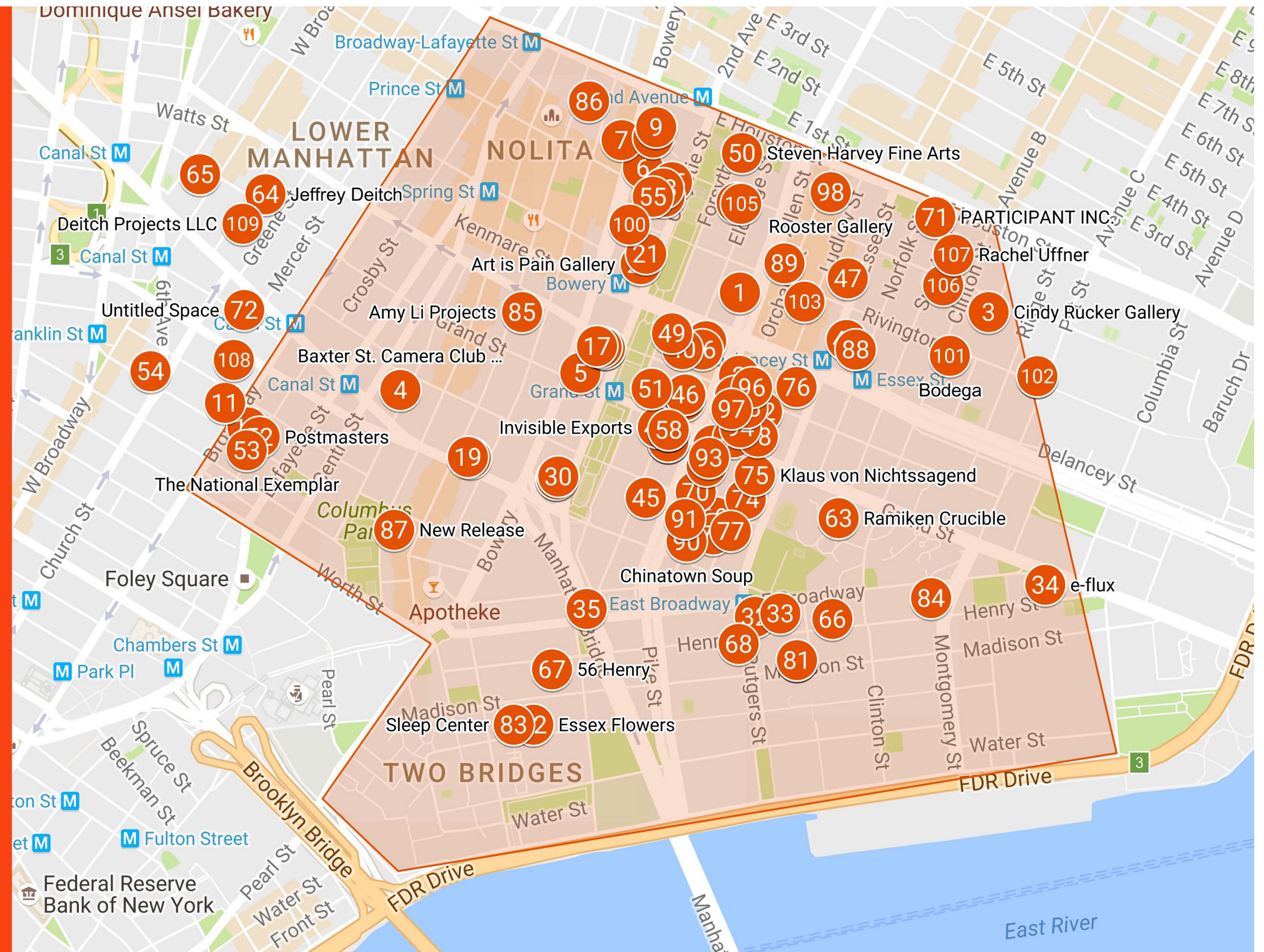
